## - Chemoth / Victory / Body -

#### READ

#### Psalm 18

31 For who is God, but the Lord? And who is a rock, except our God?— 32 the God who equipped me with strength and made my way blameless.

33 He made my feet like the feet of a deer and set me secure on the

heights.

<sup>34</sup> He trains my hands for war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze.

35 You have given me the shield of your salvation, and your right hand supported me, and your gentleness made me great.

36 You gave a wide place for my steps under me, and my feet did not slip.

37 I pursued my enemies and overtook them, and did not turn back till they were consumed.

38 I thrust them through, so that they were not able to rise:

they fell under my feet.

<sup>39</sup> For you equipped me with strength for the battle;

you made those who rise against me

sink under me.

<sup>40</sup> You made my enemies turn their backs to me, and those who hated me I destroyed.

<sup>41</sup> They cried for help, but there was

none to save;

they cried to the Lord, but he did not answer them.

<sup>42</sup> I beat them fine as dust before the wind:

I cast them out like the mire of the streets.

#### REFLECT

Reread this passage of Scripture, only this time, make a list of all the things that David states God did in order to give him victory. How many did you find?

### — Chemoth / Victory / Body —

David begins this section of Psalm 18 by asking, "For who is God, but Yahweh? And who is a rock, except our God?" And then he gives God credit for strengthening him to become blameless, listing in detail all the ways in which God has shown his might.

#### RESPOND

Bow down in submission to Yahweh. Only humility will allow you to experience his victory in your life. As you physically demonstrate your surrender to his will, bury your face in your hands and tell him all the specific things over which you desire to experience victory. Maybe there is sin that has a stranglehold on you. Maybe you are in the midst of a battle for someone's soul that seems to be hopeless.

Maybe he is calling you to respond in forgiveness and love to a situation that has had you in a bitter dispute with someone else

for years.

Submit now and allow God to give you the victory. It is not in your hands, nor in your ability to bring this about. Let Yahweh Sabaoth release his heavenly host to fight this battle for you. Remain in this posture until your soul is settled before the Lord and then...get up and offer to the Lord a time of dancing and celebrating!
